Changes in responses at Mass

NEW MISSAL - This September sees the introduction of the changes in congregational responses and text in the new edition of the Missal:

One of the new phrases is the response to **The Lord be with you** which changes from **And also with you** to **And with your spirit**: this most obvious change is used by the congregation at the beginning and end of Mass, before the Gospel, at the beginning of the Preface and at the Sign of Peace. It reminds us of the greetings of St. Paul, for example, to Timothy: 'The Lord be with your spirit', a recognition of the spirit that is among us as Christians, a spirit that we must live, and, in greeting one another, it proclaims the presence of Christ among us.
