# INTERNATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS - LOCAL EVENT

To mark the significance of the International Eucharistic Congress event in Ireland his year, parishioners from this parish are all invited to a special local celebration on *Friday June 1st at 8:00pm in Borrisokane Church*.

This celebration will involve people from the seven parishes of our Cois Deirge cluster –Borrisokane, Cloughjordan, Lorrha, Portroe, Puckane, Terryglass and Youghalarra. Parishioners are encouraged to come and to use this special celebration as an opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist together as a faith community and to pray for one another and for those who are suffering in so many places, and in a special way to remember our young people who will begin exams the following week. For those not attending the Eucharistic Congress itself, this provides an opportunity to celebrate its significance in a local setting.

To prepare for this occasion, there will be a choir practice on Monday night May 28<sup>th</sup> at 8:00pm in Borrisokane Church.

<u>SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN</u> - The following structures are in place to implement the Diocese Safeguarding Policies and Procedures:

<u>The Parish Safeguarding Representatives</u> - Each Parish has in place a minimum of two Safeguarding representatives who have received appropriate training and whose role is to set up and oversee implementation. Our two representatives are **Mike Fox** and **Grainne Fogarty**.

**Diocesan Safeguarding Committee -** The Safeguarding Committee aims to ensure That the Killaloe Diocesan Safeguarding Policies and Procedures are reviewed, updated and implemented.

<u>Advisory Panel -</u> All reports received by the Diocese in respect of allegations of child abuse are referred to the Advisory Panel who provide advice and assistance to the Bishop.

<u>The Diocesan Designated Persons -</u> The Diocesan designated persons are appointed by the Bishop to receive information about a child protection concern involving a priest, employee or volunteer and to report that concern to the civil authorities, ie: the Gardai, the HSE and the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church. <u>Support Person -</u> The Bishop appoints a Support Person to assist anyone making a disclosure/allegation of abuse.

<u>Adviser -</u> Any person against whom an allegation of child abuse has been made has an Adviser available to them who will represent their needs.
