WORLD WAR 1 REMEMBRANCE : The Kilbarron Terryglass Historical Society would like to thank all those who made the World War1 Remembrance Ceremony last Sunday a huge success. Nearly 300 people packed the village square to remember their relatives and friends who served in the war and had a connection to the parish. The Society sincerely thanks all those who assisted with stewarding, catering, setting up the square, volunteers, photographers, displays in the hall, The Garda Siochana, The Organisation of National Ex-Service Me, The North Tipperary United Nations Veterans, The Royal Red Cross, The Royal British Legion and many others. Due to the many requests to see the displays once more the Historical Society will hold an open night on Wed 6th Aug from 7-9pm in the Village Hall, Terryglass. The World War 1 research and information boards along with the slide show presentation will once again be available to be viewed on the night. The military memorabilia will not be available to view as this was loaned to the society for the day and has now been returned.
